

## **Cold Weather Tips for Apartment Residents**

When the weather conditions turn cold, it's best to be prepared. Follow these tips to help ensure you and your home stay safe:

- Never turn your furnace off in cold weather or let the room temperature fall below 55°. National Fuel Gas recommends keeping your thermostat at 68° during the winter to keep your heating costs low.
- Keep your bedroom and bathroom doors open to let the air circulate and keep you warmer.
- On very cold days, open the vanity doors under the bathroom sinks to prevent pipes from freezing (in Lake View, Scenery Hills, and Shadow Pines).

- Be sure to keep your garage door closed at all times (Village residents should crack the door when running the dryer).
- Air conditioning cannot be used in winter months.
